The bone had been broken and required the Vet to put a pin in his leg. The Friends of the Animal Shelter came to Tyt's rescue and paid for the surgery, follow-up visits and required medications.

I volunteered to foster Tyt during his initial recovery. I couldn't believe he was such a happy go lucky fella that acted like nothing had happened to him. He was very loving, liked to play with my dog (Molly), and wanted to stay by my side all the time. He would lay his head on my shoulder while resting on the couch with me.

He was supposed to take it easy with no jumping or excitement. It was a full-time job keeping him from jumping! I had to put

him up on the couch with me and always keep him on a leash when outside in a fenced in area. My fenced in area is only about three foot high and he always wanted to run & jump while only having three good legs. He only had one bad habit and that was chewing all the ears off of the dog toys.

A vet removed the pin in Tyt's leg on June 13, 2022, and he had recovered/healed completely. Tyt was adopted around June 17, 2022, to a very loving family who had another little rescue dog called Dolly. Now, Tyt has a sister named Dolly and from the photo they sent me, it looks like he is very happy and content in his furever home!

It has been a busy spring and summer season. The animal shelter was able to participate in two "Clear the Shelter" events, sponsored by grants from The Bissell Foundation. On Saturday, August 27<sup>th</sup>, in conjunction with PetSmart, the animal shelter had an onsite adoption event. Over 100 cats, dogs, kittens and puppies were available for adoption that day. 96 animals were adopted that day. What a smashing

success! This adoption event was very much needed, as the shelter has been running extremely full.

We are still fundraising for the new shelter, due to increased construction costs. However, we are happy to report, that we have now moved to the "design" phase of the project. The Friends of the Animal Shelter, the shelter staff and city representatives are working to iron out the details for this part of the campaign. Hopefully, these requirements will be ironed out soon, so that we can enter the "demolition" phase of the project.

Multiple fundraisers for our "Wags to Wishes Campaign" have happened in the last 6 months. These included the Ruff on the Bluff (\$450), Panhandling for Paws (\$1,680), Puttin' for Mutts (\$4,500), the annual 5k run/walk (\$10,000), Music Bingo at Preston's Wine Bar (\$400+), Music Bingo at River Bluff Brewing (\$600+), UPCO's 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary, St. Petrick's shopping event (\$1,432), Flower Power (\$650) and Cause for the Paws at the Rec Center (\$1756).

# **Meet Lily**

Lily came to the shelter as a stray when she was a young pup. Usually, puppies get adopted quickly since they are not very common at the shelter, but Lily is not your average puppy. Lily is deaf. The staff knew that Lily's best chance at having the best life was getting her into a foster home where she could learn basic sign language training and where she could be safe and loved until she found the perfect family who could give her the support and

training she needed to be the best girl.

Our rescue partners "Is Today My Day Rescue" were able to find a foster for Lily, where she spent several weeks in foster care preparing her for her forever home. Her foster family taught her sign language basics, how to interact appropriately with other dogs, and how to perfect her puppy dog eyes and wrap just about everyone she met around her little paw.

After a few weeks of searching for her forever home, the perfect family put in an application. Her soon to be mom was fluent in sign language and was graduating with a degree in deaf studies! We couldn't have asked for a better outcome for sweet Lily and are so happy to see her thriving in a new home.

# **Baby Kittens!**



One morning a crate containing 7 kittens was dumped at the front door of the animal shelter. Inside the crate were 7 kittens crammed inside. They ranged in age from newborn to 3 months old. All the kittens were infested with fleas and at high risk for anemia.

The shelter staff jumped into action and started to care for these babies. However, the staff knew that saving the two flea infested newborns

kittens, without a mother cat was a long shot. Newborn kittens are too delicate for any type

of flea medication, and they cannot be bathed either due to the inability to regulate their body temperature. The staff worked quickly to comb as many fleas off these fragile infants as possible.

The staff also knew the newborn kittens' chances of survival without being nursed by a mother cat was slim to none; newborn kittens NEED the antibodies and nutrients of a mother's milk. The staff decided to place the kittens in with another mother cat (Dottie) already at the shelter with hopes that the mother cat would not reject them. Dottie



gave the new kittens a good sniff and then she went right to nursing these 2 kittens along with her litter of kittens. Great outcomes for all the kittens.

# The Story of Richy



Richy was found wandering the streets of St. Joseph in late June and was brought to St. Joseph Animal Control & Rescue. He was emaciated and only weighed 30 pounds. He was full of worms and suffering from a horrible skin condition causing hair loss, swelling, pain, itching, and open wounds. Richy had been left to deteriorate and without immediate care he would not have survived.

Richy was taken to the veterinarian, who confirmed that

Richy had Demodex Mange. He was immediately started on medicine to treat this condition and within a week Richy was bouncing and playing like a happy dog!

Despite his health condition, Richy never lost his sweet disposition. He was so kind to everyone who came into contact with him. After several weeks, Richy gained 15 pounds and his fur began to return. He is handsome and happy pup! He loves to participate in play groups with other dogs. He loves people. He loves toys and learning new things. He simply loves life!



# Pet Adoption Event – By Susan Punzo

For some time, the St. Joseph Animal Shelter has seen a tremendous increase of animals coming through its doors. Periodic adoption specials have been held to reduce the influx of animals and to prevent the euthanizing of adoptable animals.

On August 27<sup>th</sup>, the largest and most successful adoption event was held in the PetSmart parking lot. At this event, 99 animals found furever homes thanks to the special adoption rates. The event was scheduled from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM, and at 8:00 AM a long line had already started to form. The adoption rates included:

- 1. There was no charge for adult cats over 6 months all 15 adult cats were adopted.
- 2. Kittens were \$10 53 kittens were adopted.
- 3. Puppies were \$25 19 puppies were adopted.
- 4. Dogs were \$25 12 dogs were adopted.

The fees include spaying/neutering, vaccinations, fecal exam, deworming, micro chipping, and city license. The shelter was able to provide all these services at a



reduced or free rate because the Friends of the Animal Shelter covered to remained for the costs.

Before this event, all cat cages and foster homes were full. After this adoption event, shelter space has been opened for animals that may be brought to the shelter in the future. Without the wonderful support from the St. Joseph community, the Friends of the Animal Shelter would not be able to finance these adoption specials; events that allow so many animals to find furever homes.
